Enrollment

- Students must be 2 – 6 years old.
- Parent/Guardian must bring the child to enroll at the school.
- Kukai Kindergarten is a day school
- Student are allocated into classes by age groups.

What to bring on Enrollment Day

- Parent/Guardian must fill in the application form and must present a copy of the student's birth certificate and house registration.
- Doctor's Certification.
(Please see the application form)
- 3 Recent passport photographs of the child's 2 x1.5 inches.
(taken within 3 months)



School Fees Payment

For new students, school fees for one term must be paid on the enrollment day and for other terms the payment date will be informed to parents by a letter.

School Terms

There are two terms in
one academic year

For new students, there will be half-day classes
for the first 6 days before the beginning of term.

Parents and new students

For new students, the school allows parents (parents only)
to accompany the student to school and the spend
the morning with the student at school for three days and
the student may finish school after lunch for the first week.
This is to ensure that the child settles in comfortably at school.

School Holiday

- School is closed every Saturday and Sunday.
- School is closed every Thai official holidays.
- There are 2 mid term breaks per term.
(please see the school calendar)

Illness

- If the student has any illness (including common colds) the student must stay at home until he/she has fully recovered and parents must inform the school every time via telephone or email.

Moving up Year Groups

- There are no examinations.
- Classes are divided according to student's progress and development.
- At the end of K3 each student will receive a certificate of education.

Drop off and Pick Up

1. The school will issue each parent with a student 'pickup card'.
2. Each parent must present this card when collecting the student.
3. The school will only allow student to go home when the 'pickup card' is present.
4. If the card is lost or stolen, parents must inform the school immediately for security reasons.

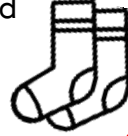
Leaving the school

1. All belongings must be clearly named including socks, shoes and handkerchief.

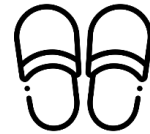


2. - One set of toothbrush and toothpaste.

Clothing Rules and Regulations

Students must wear black school shoes. For sports, Students must wear sports shoes for running.

Students must bring one set of clean home clothes to change in the afternoon.



Students must bring one set of pajamas to school everyday for the afternoon nap. (For Nursery students only)
